Annual Lube: Auxillary Air Slide

At least once a year, it is important to lubricate the auxillary air slide. This is because they are now unobtainable from Bosch, and they tend to seize.

- Warm up the engine, and switch off.
- Locate the auxiliary air slide (alloy unit bolted to the RHF of the cylinder head)
- Pull off the upper hose
- Douse the mechanism visible with releasing oil or WD40.
- Repeat on several hot/cold cycles

This will prevent the mechanism from seizing, which would result in very high idle speeds.

<u>Distributor Vacuum "Advance" Modification, B20E</u>

The only simple useful modification is to consider disabling the vacuum retard mechanism from the distributor: this is installed simply to meet USA emissions legislation, and really lets the motor run poorly for most of the time.

- Blank off the vacuum retard at the manifold take-off
- Set the timing for about 9.5° BTDC at 900rpm idle (32° BTDC maximum advance)
